## Finance/Treasury, Maintenance, Membership and Interment Committee Rules

If created by the Board either temporarily or permanently, and always subject to the current Bylaws, the Finance/Treasury Committee, Maintenance Committee, Membership Committee, and Interment Committee shall operate pursuant to the following rules:

## Finance/Treasury Committee

The purpose of the Finance/Treasury Committee is to assist the Treasurer in his or her official functions. The Treasurer shall serve as chair of this committee.

## Maintenance Committee

The purpose of the Maintenance Committee is to be responsible for the scheduling and payment recommendation for any maintenance or improvement of the grounds, monuments (the Association is not responsible for, but may elect to maintain or require family maintenance of, monuments), access to, or fencing of the Association's property.

Committee Members (indicate Chair):

## Membership Committee

The purpose of the Membership Committee is to review and make recommendations to the Board on membership applications. This committee shall always have an odd number of at least three (3) members and requires a three-member quorum to transact business.

Upon receipt of an application, the Membership Committee shall vote on and make its recommendation to the Board. The Board may accept the Committee's recommendation by simple majority vote, but may only reject the recommendation by unanimous vote.

Committee Members (indicate Chair):

## Interment Committee

The purpose of the Interment Committee is to review and make recommendations to the Board on burial applications. This committee shall always have an odd number of at least three (3) members and requires a three-member quorum to transact business.

Upon receipt of an application, the Interment Committee shall vote on and make its recommendation to the Board. The Board may accept the Committee's recommendation by simple majority vote (subject to Article III, section 2 ), but may only reject the recommendation by unanimous vote. If the Interment Committee receives a burial application from a living Spouse Member, the Committee should take no action on the application.
